

**RESOLUTION NO. 950-2023**

A RESOLUTION CANVASSING THE VOTE FOR THE 06 MAY 2023 GENERAL ELECTION, DECLARING THE CANDIDATES ELECTED, AND REQUIRING THE OATH OF OFFICE.

WHEREAS, the laws of the State of Texas requires that the City of Universal City, Texas, hold an election on the first Saturday in May to elect City Council members; and,

WHEREAS, the City of Universal City, Texas, entered into a joint election contract with the Bexar County Elections Department t to conduct its municipal election; and

WHEREAS, said Election was held on Saturday, 06 May 2023, for the purpose of electing three Councilmembers; and

WHEREAS, the City Charter requires the City Council to be the Canvassing Board of said Elections; and,

WHEREAS, the City Charter states that at any Regular or Special Municipal Election the candidates for each office up to the number to be elected to any one office who have received the greater number of votes cast in such election shall be declared elected; and,

WHEREAS, the Election was duly and legally held in conformity with the election laws of the State of Texas, and the results of said election have been verified and returned by the properly appointed Bexar County judges and clerks and that the said respective CANDIDATES have received the following number of votes:

**FOR CITY COUNCILMEMBER (TWO-YEAR TERM)**

Christina Fitzpatrick	716
Bernard Rubal	506
Richard (Dick) Neville	462
S. Bear Goolsby	591
Richard Edwards	340

*NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF UNIVERSAL CITY, TEXAS, THAT:*

1. The City Council officially finds and determines that said general election was duly ordered; proper notice of said election was duly given; proper election officers were duly appointed prior to said election; said election was duly held; the City has complied with the Federal Voting Rights Act and the Texas Election Code; due returns of the result of said election has been made and delivered; and the City Council has duly canvassed said returns, all in accordance with law and the Resolution calling the election.
2. The City Council officially finds and determines that 3,201 (6 Guadalupe county, 3,195 Bexar County) residents, qualified electors of the City cast their votes, with 2,315 electors casting ballots during Early Voting and 822 electors casting ballots on Election Day.
3. The City Council officially finds and determines that a Runoff Election is not required and that the following candidates are declared to be the elected City officials in the named capacity as elected by resident, qualified electors of the City who voted at the election:

**FOR CITY COUNCILMEMBER**

Christina Fitzpatrick (with 716 votes)  
S. Bear Goolsby (with 591 votes)  
Ashton Bulman (with 586 votes)


4. The City Council officially finds, determines, and declares that the elected Councilmembers shall be for a two-year term, effective upon taking the Oath of Office.
