

RESOLUTION NO. 622

A RESOLUTION CANVASSING THE VOTE OF THE 12 AUGUST 1995 SPECIAL ELECTION AND DECLARING ITS RESULTS FOR THE ADOPTION OF AN ADDITIONAL ONE-HALF OF ONE PERCENT (1/2 CENT) LOCAL SALES AND USE TAX TO BE USED BY A CITY INDUSTRIAL DEVELOPMENT CORPORATION FOR THE PROMOTION AND DEVELOPMENT OF NEW AND EXPANDED BUSINESS ENTERPRISES AND ANY OTHER PURPOSE AUTHORIZED BY SECTION 4B, ARTICLE 5190.6, V.T.C.S., AS AMENDED, (THE DEVELOPMENT CORPORATION ACT OF 1979).

WHEREAS, The City Council of the City of Universal City, Texas, ordered an election to be held in the City on August 12, 1995, on the PROPOSITION hereinafter stated; and

WHEREAS, The City Council of the City of Universal City convened in Regular Meeting on the 15th day of August, 1995, at the City Hall, and the roll was called of the duly constituted officers and members of said City Council, and it was found that all members of said Council were present, thus constituting a quorum; and

WHEREAS, The City Council has investigated all matters pertaining to said election, including the ordering, giving notice, officers, holding and making returns of said election; and

WHEREAS, The election officers who held said election have duly made the returns of the result thereof, and said returns have been duly delivered to the City Council.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF UNIVERSAL CITY, TEXAS, THAT:

1. The City Council officially finds and determines that said election was duly ordered; proper notice of said election was duly given; proper election officers were duly appointed prior to said election; said election was duly held; the City has complied with the Federal Voting Rights Act and the Texas Election Code; due returns of the result of said election have been made and delivered; and the City Council has duly canvassed said returns, all in accordance with law and the Ordinance calling the election.
2. The City Council officially finds and determines that 566 total votes were cast by resident, qualified electors of the City, with 204 electors casting their ballots during Early Voting and 362 electors casting their ballots on Election Day.
3. The City Council officially finds and determines that the following votes were cast at said election on the submitted PROPOSITION by the resident, qualified electors of the City who voted at the election:

390 VOTES FOR
176 VOTES AGAINST

ADOPTION OF AN ADDITIONAL ONE-HALF OF ONE PERCENT (1/2 CENT) LOCAL SALES AND USE TAX TO BE USED BY A CITY INDUSTRIAL DEVELOPMENT CORPORATION FOR THE PROMOTION AND DEVELOPMENT OF NEW AND EXPANDED BUSINESS ENTERPRISES AND ANY OTHER PURPOSE AUTHORIZED BY SECTION 4B, ARTICLE 5190.6, V.T.C.S., AS AMENDED, (THE DEVELOPMENT CORPORATION ACT OF 1979).

4. The City Council officially finds, determines, and declares the result of said election to be that the PROPOSITION so submitted has received a favorable majority vote in all respects and has carried by a majority vote of 390.
5. The aforesaid one-half percent (1/2 cent) sales tax may be levied, assessed, and collected as voted and as provided by law.
