

Universal City Public Library Senior Bingo Program Policy

The Universal City Public Library provides a Young @ Heart Program for senior citizens which includes a bingo program for persons sixty (60) years of age or over. The bingo program is solely for the purpose of amusement and recreation of senior citizens in the community. The program is intended to promote social, mental and physical wellness.

- There is no charge for participating in the program.
- Participants must be at least sixty (60) years of age. An individual that provides assistance that is necessary for an individual to attend and participate in the program, may participate in a bingo session.
- Prizes awarded will be of nominal value. For purposes of this policy “nominal value” is defined as not more than ten dollars (\$10.00).
- The Library Director may work with the Universal City Friends of the Library for the donation of prizes.
- The bingo program will not be used for any fundraising or commercial purposes. A “commercial purpose” is defined as a use intended to produce, or which in fact produces, profit for any private for-profit company, association, corporation, or individual.
- The library reserves the right to require proof of a participant’s age.
- All participants are subject to the Library’s Code of Conduct and all other rules for use of Library facilities.
- The Library Director’s decisions on schedule, prizes and other related matters are final.
